




Fig. 1 Forward current versus voltage drop




Fig. 2 Surge overload current  $I_{\text{FSM}}$ : Crest value, t: duration




Fig. 3 I<sup>2</sup>t versus time (1-10 ms)




Fig.4 Power dissipation versus forward current and ambient temperature (per diode)




Fig. 5 Maximum forward current at case temperature




Fig.6 Three phase rectifier bridge: Power dissipation versus direct output current and ambient temperature




Fig. 7 Rated RMS current versus time (360° conduction)




Fig. 8 Transient thermal impedance junction to case
